

MINUTES BIENNIAL GENERAL MEETING

Holiday Inn-Cherry Creek, Denver, CO August 4, 2017

The Biennial General Meeting began at approximately 9 a.m. under the leadership of Jim Clark.

An uncontested slate of 14 board members was elected by acclamation.
